CITY OF COLD SPRING
AMENDING THE ZONING
ORDINANCE TO EXEMPT
CERTAIN AREAS FROM
PARKING LOT CURB
REQUIREMENTS**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLD SPRING, STEARNS COUNTY, MINNESOTA HEREBY ORDAINS:
SUBDIVISION 1. Section 17, General Regulations, Subdivision 12, Off-street Parking and Loading, of the City of Cold Spring Zoning Ordinance, shall be amended as follows (new material is underlined; deleted material is lined out; sections which are not proposed to be amended are omitted; sections which are only proposed to be re-numbered are only set forth below as to their number and title):

Subdivision 12. Off-street Parking and Loading.

5. Parking Design Standards. All parking spaces and associated vehicle accommodation areas shall meet the following minimum design requirements:

j. Curbed islands. Curbed islands shall be required around the perimeter, at the ends of and between parking aisles for traffic control or drainage control, except that this requirement shall not apply within the Cold Spring Business Park, which is defined as the area located north and west of Stearns County Road 2 and east of 2nd Avenue North, with lot frontages on 11th Street Northeast, 10th Street Northeast, 1st Avenue Northeast, or Krays Mill Road, so long as the owner provides for proper drainage of the parking lot in a manner that does not increase stormwater runoff for adjacent properties or public rights-of-way, as approved by the City's engineer.
SUBDIVISION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.

Purpose: The local governments (Douglas County & SWCD, Pope County & SWCD, Sauk River Watershed District, Stearns County & SWCD, Todd County & SWCD) comprising the Sauk River Watershed Collaborative are utilizing the procedure of a minor amendment to the 10-year Sauk River Comprehensive Watershed Management Plan.

Review of information: This minor plan amendment involves the addition of a feasibility study for the modification of the Cold Spring Dam (the outlet of the Sauk River Chain of lakes) into a set of "rock arched rapids".
